Footnotes

TINNERS BUCKS was well placed on the outside of SMART APPEAL, made a three wide bid near the three-furlong marker, took the lead at the top of the stretch, battled gamely in the final furlong and was fully extended to just hold on. BLUE SONG set the pace through moderate fractions, was headed at the top of the stretch, fought back gamely on the inside and just missed. SMART APPEAL was rated on the inside, came off the rail then was roused on the second turn and earned the show while no match for the top two. LEXIESRIDE was reserved off the pace, came under a ride while three wide on the far turn and failed to respond. SHANNON LEE was unhurried well behind the field, came three wide into the stretch and failed to threaten. MY SWEET LUCY pressed the pace on the outside, came up empty on the second turn and retreated. WHISPERIN GIRL raced three wide on the first turn, settled towards the rear of the field and showed little.
