PLATINUM BALLETT angled in after the start, was unhurried well off the pace, rallied on the far turn, came three wide into the stretch, closed strongly to take the lead passing the furlong marker and drew away while ridden out in an impressive performance. LAVENDER BABY contested the pace on the inside, inched clear in upper stretch, was collared passing the furlong marker and proved no match for the winner while clear for second. KRISTINA'S WISH stalked the pace while three wide, was roused near the quarter-pole, came up empty in upper stretch and gave way. HAPPY JACKIE lagged well behind the field, raced three wide on the second turn and failed to threaten. MISS DRAGON was well placed on the inside, saved ground through the far turn, was roused at the top of the stretch and came up empty. SONYA'S SMILE contested the pace on the outside, dropped out on the second turn and stopped.
