Footnotes

SANIBEL SUNSET stalked the pace on the inside, was boxed in on the second turn, shifted four wide inside the quarter-pole, quickly surged to the lead at the top of the stretch and drew away while ridden out. ERIMOS (IRE) was well placed just off the pace, made a three wide bid midway through the far turn, led briefly inside the quarter-pole and proved no match for the winner while clear for second. SMART APPEAL was rated at the back of the compact field, raced four wide on the second turn and bested the rest while no match for the top two. DANZIGCA pressed the pace on the outside, drew even near the half-mile marker, vied between rivals on the far turn and faded. QUEEN OF THE ISLE was fractious in the gate, set the pace under steady pressure, vied through the far turn and stopped.
