Footnotes

SPEIGHTSTOWN was well placed on the inside, saved ground on the turn, slipped through to make a bid at the top of the stretch, edged clear into the final furlong and held well under strong right hand urging. KELA was outrun early, raced three to four wide on the turn, swung seven wide leaving the turn, drifted inward in upper stretch and finished well while unable to reach the winner. MY COUSIN MATT settled towards the rear of the field, angled in late on the backstretch, saved ground on the turn, shifted out near the furlong marker and finished willingly. BWANA CHARLIE lacked early speed, shifted five wide near the quarter-pole, swung eight wide into the stretch and improved position. CAJUN BEAT was ridden along on the outside, vied three to four wide on the turn, lacked room near the sixteenth-pole and failed to rally. CLOCK STOPPER was completely void of speed, saved ground on the turn, angled out in

upper stretch then again near the sixteenth-pole and failed to menace while finishing with some interest. CHAMPALI shifted outside near the five-furlong marker, was ridden along while three wide on the turn, bumped repeatedly with OUR NEW RECRUIT near the three-sixteenths marker and came up empty. PT'S GREY EAGLE dropped well back in the field, saved ground on the turn, angled out in upper stretch, lacked room late and never reached serious contention. GOLD STORM was bumped at the start, chased the pace on the outside, vied three wide on the turn, made a bid near the quarter-pole, drifted in while briefly in the lead passing the three-sixteenths marker and tired. MIDAS EYES was urged along on the outside, raced four wide on the turn, floated six wide leaving the turn, was forced inward in upper stretch and had nothing left. ABBONDANZA set the pace through quick fractions, was in tight while losing the lead near the three-sixteenths marker and faded. OUR NEW RECRUIT steadied repeatedly on the backstretch, raced off the rail on the turn, bumped repeatedly with CHAMPALI and steadied near the three-sixteenths marker then stopped in a rough trip. CUVEE broke inward and bumped a rival, chased the pace on the outside, vied three wide on the turn, was jostled in upper stretch and stopped.
