Footnotes

OUIJA BOARD (GB) taken in hand soon after the start, was rated in good position for a mile, launched a rally three wide leaving the turn, rapidly closed the gap in upper stretch, accelerated to the front inside the furlong marker then drew clear under steady right hand encouragement. FILM MAKER settled just behind the early leader, raced just off the pace for a mile, edged closer on the turn, made a run to threaten at the quarter pole, battled into upper stretch, but couldn't stay with the winner while holding well for the place. WONDER AGAIN was outrun for six furlongs, gradually worked her way forward along the inside midway on the turn, saved ground into the stretch, angled out in upper stretch then rallied belatedly to gain a share. MOSCOW BURNING sprinted well clear in the early stages, set a moderate pace along the inside to the top of the stretch, fought gamely into midstretch then weakened from her early efforts. YESTERDAY (IRE) dwelt at the start breaking well behind the field, rushed up between horses shortly thereafter, was in the middle of the pack for seven furlongs, rallied inside the winner to threaten nearing the quarter pole but couldn't sustain her bid. SHACONAGE raced far back to the turn and failed to threaten while improving her position. LIGHT JIG (GB) failed to mount a serious rally. RISKVERSE steadied while rank in the early stages, raced in the middle of the pack along the backstretch, lodged a brief bid while three wide on the turn then faded in the stretch. SUPER BRAND (SAF) was unhurried for a half, angled out along the backstretch, swung seven wide leaving the turn then lacked a strong closing response. KATDOGAWN (GB) checked between

horses in the early stages, was outrun for a mile, circled six wide entering the stretch then lacked a further response. MEGAHERTZ (GB) raced within striking distance while five wide for most of the way and faded in the stretch. AUBONNE (GER), up close while three wide for a mile, dropped back on the turn and steadily tired thereafter.
