### Footnotes

RUM SQUALL led early, stalked the pace after four fences, gained command again after the fourteenth fence, drew off and won in hand. FRA DIAVOLO (ARG) was unhurried early while racing near the back of the pack, steadily advanced into the stretch and proved narrowly best of the remaining finishers. JOHN LAW was outrun through fourteen fences, had a mild rally into the stretch and was very well handled when landing between the fallen horses and riders after the final fence. KIRIMBAI raced in the middle of the pack and had no rally. PUKKA (NZ) was unruly and ran off in the post parade, stalked the pace, bumped HUMDINGER off course at the fourth fence and tired after ten fences. Following a stewards' inquiry, PUKKA (NZ) was disqualified for bumping HUMDINGER and placed sixth and out of the money. JIMMIE ECHO was unruly pre-race and threw his rider in the paddock, stalked the early pace, led after four fences and weakened after the fourteenth fence. DYNAWAY trailed to the fourteenth fence, rallied into the stretch, struck THE NEXT MAN after the final fence and fell. THE NEXT MAN (IRE) raced in the middle of the pack, steadily advanced to stalk the pace, rallied well into the stretch and fell at the final fence. RED LETTER DAY raced in the middle of the pack, rallied well into the stretch and fell at the final fence. SOCCA BEAT (CHI) was outrun, stumbled at the tenth fence and pulled up before the second-last fence. HUMDINGER was well placed saving ground when he was forced off course by PUKKA (NZ) at the fourth fence, unseating his rider.
