MR. GRUMPY STRIPES was allowed to settle in the early going then started a run on the far turn while two wide, was in between rivals in the stretch and gamely dug in to prove best in the end. WINDY LOU was allowed to settle then started a rally on the far turn while three wide, was in a long drive and gamely dug in but hung in late stretch. BID FROM BOURTAI was sent right to the front to set the pace, opened a clear lead on the backstretch then was in a long drive in the stretch but weakened in late stretch. BURBON ROAD was unhurried early then made a mild rally along the inside on the far turn but was no menace in the stretch. BURBERRY BULLET was unhurried early and failed to menace. TAKSENT was three wide on the backstretch, was used up and faltered in the stretch. ROQUE'S BLUES hopped at the start then was in tight going into the first turn and was no factor. CROOK'S ADVENTURE was through after a half. PLAY THE CHIME was brief speed and stopped on the backstretch. Sets a new track record.
