RUN PAST THEE unhurried early, gaining, weakened stretch. VISCOUNT VICTOR G middle of pack, taken back, never dangerous. MR. FEBRUARY no threat. SUNDAY SAMURAI away alertly, faded. TOP OF THE HEAP outrun.
