PERFECT HONEY away alertly, dueled, weakened upper stretch. CRITICAL CHOICE good position, mild rally, lacked late response. NO IMAGE evenly, no threat. SUZY'S SUCCESS middle of pack, taken back, flattened out. STARIZ MARK reared in gate. ALLY SCATTER good position, evenly, faded. JAKES LADY LUCK trailed, outrun.
