I'M SUE unhurried early, steady advance, lacked late response. AT A BOY LUTHER never dangerous. HALO'S LIMIT middle of pack, evenly, failed to respond. HE'S A BARN RAT passed tiring rivals. HONEST BREW showed little. TIZMENOW away alertly, chased, weakened, tired.
