J C'S ACTION away alertly, set pace, dueled, drew clear mid stretch, driving. KING ROSE evenly, closed fast 2nd turn, dueled, gave way mid stretch. SUPER G away alertly, chased, weakened 2nd turn. SADLERS MILL middle of pack, evenly, lacked late response. BOUND BY JUSTICE never dangerous. TRICKY SMILE stalked pace, faltered 3/8 pole. WELL SPENT showed little. STEEL THE BLUES outrun.
