AVODIXIE stalked SWEET REGRET for four furlongs, dueled with that one down the backstretch to the top of the stretch, gained command with a sixteenth to go, prevailed under strong urging. HARDY HAR raced evenly to the top of the stretch, rallied through the final furlong, finished second best. SWEET REGRET set the pace for four furlongs, dueled with the winner down the backstretch to the top of the stretch, then gave way in mid stretch. BET ONCE raced evenly to the top of the stretch, then lacked a good closing response. SEA HATCH was taken back and showed little. BUFFALO BOY was no factor and was outrun.
