QUITE A BRIDE moved off the inside and under a rating hold early, vied for command outside a rival, held the advantage turning for home then responded to pressure while drawing clear. KITTY HAWK (GB) saved ground into the far turn, moved out for the drive and finished steadily while earning the place. SOUTHERN PROTOCOL close up early outside, raced four wide turning for home and advanced into midstretch then lacked the needed late response. ROBYNS ANTHEM saved ground to the lane, eased out and offered a mild gain. MERIBEL raced just off the inside into the lane and was checked between rivals when lacking room nearing the furlong marker dropping back. CELESTIAL WOODS close up early inside, lodged a three wide bid on the final turn, drifted in some nearing the eighth pole and tired. CAPOZZENE moved up inside approaching the clubhouse turn and vied for the lead, continued to save ground to the lane, came out slightly nearing the furlong marker and weakened. KARLA'S NUMBER stumbled at the start, raced forwardly placed from the outside to the far turn and tired.
