SIXTY ROCKETTS saved ground to the far turn, eased out and advanced three wide to challenge for the lead turning for home then finished well while drawing out the final sixteenth. IWOMAN broke out some then tracked early, lodged a bid on the final turn and reached the front then continued on willingly while second best. SCHOLASTIC GIANT bumped with a rival at the start, lodged a bid outside on the last turn and was gaining late. PERFECT BLEND (GB) set the early pace, saved ground and weakened in the drive. TUCKERED raced between foes entering the far turn and lacked the needed response. STELLA NOVA saved ground and lacked a bid. FLAANK INN raced well placed early, was just off the inside turning for home and weakened. ELOQUENTLY bumped with a rival at the start, prompted the early issue and had little left entering the lane. SHOOT THE WAD lacked a response.
