Footnotes

TEASING TARA dropped back and was unhurried early, rallied six wide through the far turn, came slightly in entering the stretch then dueled to the lead in the final sixteenth and held off a late challenge from the runner up. COGENT raced unhurriedly near the rail, was checked entering the far turn, swung to the far outside through the turn and rallied quickly on the outside of the stretch. CHIM CHIMINEY (GB) was steadied into the first turn then steadied again nearing the far turn, lacked room through the turn, angled six wide entering the stretch then offered only a mild bid. WON MORO came out a step slow, lacked room through the far turn, went to the outside in midstretch and finished up well. DARE TO COPE was rated close to the pace, made a bid nearing the quarter pole, had a short brief lead in midstretch then weakened drifting slightly in. MISTY SPRINGS raced just off the pace toward the inside, moved close on the rail in midstretch then flattened out. PRINCESS HA HA raced just off the pace toward the outside, was bothered and steadied briefly in the upper stretch and leveled off. RUSSIAN MARKET advanced to the early lead, maintained a slight lead through the upper stretch then weakened from between horses. LILITH was rated just off the pace and tired while under a drive. COLONIAL BANNER raced just off the pace and tired.
