SO EXCITED rated close to the pace four wide, made her bid off the rail rounding the final turn, dueled with a short lead through the stretch and dug in determinedly to hold on. PROUD AND FREE rated off the pace five wide, started her bid three wide through the final turn, dueled toward the inside through the stretch but was outfinished in a game try. CLASSY AGENDA was jostled at the break, rated off the pace five wide, made her bid through the final turn and finished evenly for show. PETIONVILLE PRIDE was rated close five wide then proved empty for the drive. SALINA'S GIFT raced five wide the opening turn, took the lead into the backstretch and rated a clear pace, saved ground through the final turn, was a factor to midstretch then gave way. PORTOBELLO BELLE raced off the pace on the outside, angled in saving some ground through the final turn then was empty in the stretch. APPOLLO NORTH raced three and four wide and offered no rally. CAMEO'S COVERGIRL was shuffled back at the break, dropped back early and was never a factor. SUMMER CHARM set the early pace, remained close through the back stretch then weakened into the final turn. WELL PROTECTED raced widest the opening turn and was never a factor.
