QUICK 'N SMART vied for the early lead, drew clear on the turn and widened into midstretch then remained clear to the wire. STAR SUITE bumped at the start, saved ground and was steadily gaining late. BARRACOUTA pressed the early issue then drifted out through the stretch run. SNOOPY'S LAST stayed outside and lacked a solid bid. RILEY'S HEAT pressed the early issue, was herded out through the stretch run and weakened. PEARLS OF GLORY lacked a rally. MISS KITTY'S CITY was bumped at the start, raced forwardly placed to the lane and tired. QUIDNASKRA trailed and raced extremely wide. Following a stewards inquiry concerning the stretch run, BARRACOUTA was disqualified from third and placed fifth for interference.
