Footnotes

THE FUSE rated the lead in the three path, responded well to pressure and opened up through the stretch. TERRA CYNTHUS raced unhurriedly in the three path, started her bid through the turn and advanced steadily just getting up for place. SPRIGHT drifted in early then stalked the pace four wide, angled to the inside in midstretch and weakened on the rail late. SERIOUS SUSAN dropped back early on angling toward the outside, made a mild bid in the five path through the turn and finished evenly widest. PRIVY rated close four wide, dropped back angling in on the turn the proved empty for the drive. NORTHERN KALI was pinched back on the chute, chased the pace from the outside, improved her position widest nearing the turn then faltered through the stretch. WAY FAST BEAUTY was steadied briefly at the start then showed no speed saving ground. SHES NOT IDOL rated close five and six wide, angled in saving some ground on the turn then faded.
