APRIL SQUALL was rated back, advanced through traffic on the far turn, gained full momentum from the eighth pole then edged ahead late. PINE BARONESS took the lead entering the backstretch, rated the pace, drew clear entering the stretch then was caught in the final yards. DANZIG'S EDGE raced close to the pace, stayed in contention to the eighth pole then faded. ISBELL AMBIEL raced just off the pace, made her bid between horses in the far turn then ran empty in the stretch. SHOT BLOCKER came out a step slow, advanced through the far turn then was empty for the stretch run. SOAP OPERA raced off the pace on the outside, ran evenly on the far turn then had no rally. REHEARSE chased the pace three deep then faded from the middle of the far turn. EXPLOSIVE PRINCESS was rated back saving ground and offered no rally. SILENT PRAYER was rated close on the outside, remained close through the far turn then gave way. SALLY Q took the early lead and angled in for position, dropped back on the backstretch then gave way after a half mile.
