TOOKIN DOWN was controlling the speed from the start, held a clear lead into the stretch and held on gamely while drifting out badly in the final furlong. PROUD RUN was in close attendance with the leaders while five wide early, was asked for her best four wide on the final turn, angled to the inside in the upper stretch and ran out of ground late. DARLING ALICE chased the leaders three wide early, was asked for her best four wide on the final turn and finished willingly late. PROUD OWNER was devoid of early speed, commenced a rally four wide on the far turn and flattened out a bit in the late stages. RAP AND DANCE hustled along early close on the pace, but weakened in the upper stretch. ABSOLUTELY QUEENIE veered in at the start, stalked the leaders three wide early and weakened in the upper stretch. POWERFUL NATION chased the leaders in the second flight of horses and was not a serious factor.
