WILMA LEE angled in at the break taking the early lead, moved clear entering the stretch and kept to a drive. GO CAROLINA was steadied nearing the turn, made a four wide bid through the turn then dueled in the stretch for place. KARLA'S VICTORY showed no speed early on, gathered momentum near the rail through the stretch and finished well. POLISH SPENDER rallied to position on the turn, lost some ground entering the stretch then leveled off in the drive. PRAIRIE PRINCESS was steadied between horses nearing the turn, came back on the outside through the turn then flattened out in the stretch. BRIANNA DES PINS came out a step slow and offered no rally. CUPID'S COMET saved ground and offered no rally. REBUY was outrun.
