CRASH COURSE raced unhurriedly down the backstretch, angled to the far outside at the top of the stretch, rallied and moved clear in the final strides. SOLITARY DANCER was brushed at the break then raced unhurriedly, lacked room on the far turn, rallied with the winner in the stretch, was outfinished but got the nod for place. UNION ONE raced close just off the pace off the rail, made a bid nearing the far turn, was in range of the front late but outfinished. DR. KASHNIKOW raced just off the pace, made a bid through the far turn, was close late but leveled off. NIGHT PATROL, off the pace, made a bid from between horses from the top of the stretch, closed well on the rail and finished with energy. STRATEGIC MISSION raced close on the inside, moved clear into the far turn, maintained the lead to late stretch then tired nearing the wire. ROLLED STOCKING raced just off the pace to the outside, was six wide through the turn then empty in the drive. COASTAL ACCOUNT was brushed at the start, raced unhurriedly and offered no rally. STOKOSKY, off the pace, made a mild bid through the far turn then weakened. REGAL BULL was up for the early lead, overcome nearing the far turn then gave way.
