CURIOUS TREASURES was hustled up along the inside, steadied into the turn, angled to the outside of the early leaders through the turn, made her bid outside through the stretch, dueled gamely to the wire and edged ahead in the final yards. DESERT SKY (IRE) chased the pace, came between horses entering the stretch, dueled gamely to a short late lead but outfinished in the final yards. JERA showed no early speed, angled out looking for room entering the stretch and was closing while getting wider late. TUNABILITY was hustled clear on the outside early, remained clear to the eighth pole then weakened near the rail late. ANYTHING FOR YOU raced off the pace, had a mild advance on the turn then offered no significant bid. AYANULI showed no early speed and offered no rally. C. R. PACE chased the leader through the backstretch, was steadied nearing the quarter pole, dropped back inside into the stretch and gave way. ADORAHY chased the early pace then gave way.
