CHERRY FLAMBE devoid of any early speed, rallied five wide in the stretch and was bumped soundly near the wire. WOLF ALERT made a bid for the lead three wide on the final turn and finished with interest. MARY'S SILVER PEN rallied nicely along the rail on the turn, floated out three wide in the stretch and finished gamely. A LIL BRIGHT LIGHT ran evenly. PEARLS OF GLORY set the pace along the inside and shorten strides in the final furlong. TUNABILITY steadied at the four furlong pole, was forced to steady again on the final turn, brushed the rail at that point and ran evenly late. MS. GHAZI tired after early efforts up front. CHARMS WAY dwelt at the start. THE STEWARDS REVIEWED THE START OF THE CONTEST REGARDING CHARMS WAY AND DECIDED THAT THE GATE OPEN WITH THE REST OF THE FIELD AND THAT NO REFUNDS WOULD BE GIVEN ON THIS RUNNER.
