INCURABLE OPTIMIST, middle of pack, steadily advanced backstretch, was blocked 1/4 pole, drew clear late. IMAGINARY SWORD pressed pace, dropped back 1/4 pole, finished well. THANKS FRANKS dueled, drew clear 1/4 pole, failed to stay. HERVY, middle of pack, lacked late response. DIXIE VICTORY steadied first turn, steady advance, lacked late response. GROOMSTICK STOCK'S, 5 wide first turn, 4 wide 2nd turn, no rally. YOUKNOWWHATIMEAN, slow early, rallied 4 wide 2nd turn, no threat. ARIEL CHIEF, 4 wide first turn, stalked pace, gave way 1/4 pole. SMART GUY steadied first turn, stalked pace, gave way upper stretch. REGAL FLASH was outrun. TWO PUNCH SONNY steadied and bore out first turn, outrun. REPROOF, forced wide first turn, outrun.
