TOMORROWS CAT pressed pace, drew clear 1/4 pole and was kept to steady urging. LIMIT OUT, unhurried early, advanced 3 wide backstretch, bid 1/4 pole but couldn't gain on the winner. COMIC STRIP, unhurried early, split horses rallying 3/8 pole, lacked late bid. ROCK AND ROLL rushed to lead, set pressured pace inside, gave way mid stretch. BARTER TOWN saved ground, no rally. ARCTIC SWEEP, 3 wide turns, tired.
