CLOUD CITY was steadied briefly at the start then moved close to the pace, made a bid from between horses at the top of the stretch then persevered a long stretch drive to get up late. ALWAYS ON THE GO advanced to the early lead, moved clear entering the stretch, was under a hard drive through the stretch but was outfinished nearing the wire. GOTTA BE A STAR showed no early speed then rallied while angling to the outside entering the stretch and was gaining steadily through the stretch. AYRES HALL was rated close to the pace, then put to a drive through the stretch, boxed in late stretch and finished willingly. GOLDEN GLOW showed no speed, was steadied on the rail nearing the quarter pole, lacked room through the upper stretch, angled out and closed when able. SEA O' LOVE chased the pace, ran five wide through the turn then closed to late stretch and leveled off late. TWILIGHTS PRAYER raced off the pace, angled six wide leaving the quarter pole then was empty outside late. MIXED TRUCE's rider lost his irons leaving the gate, raced off the pace, was widest on the turn and had no rally. MISSPENT was outrun. PEG RUSHTON showed good early speed pressing the pace then gave way from the quarter pole.
