DRUM MAJOR rated close about the three path, started a drive leaving the quarter pole, moved alongside the pacesetter toward the sixteenth pole and gradually edged ahead. CLERPARK rated the pace inside, remained clear to midstretch then reluctantly yielded the final sixteenth. SPRING HOUSE kept off the pace toward mid track, bid nearing the final turn and finished evenly for show. MONSTER AFFAIR rated just off the early pace inside, was boxed in on the rail through the final turn, had aim entering the stretch but leveled off toward the wire. LIGHTNING POWER rated off the pace in the three path, was briefly boxed in entering the stretch then finished evenly inside. CHIEF COMMANDER rated off the pace inside, eased out entering the stretch and finished evenly. HE DEVIL never factored and drifted out the final furlong. DAVY JONES hesitated at the start then broke in the air.
