Footnotes

MAGNA GRADUATE kept in close contention inside through the backstretch, came off the rail making his bid approaching the quarter pole, dug in determinedly through the stretch and was pulling clear toward the wire. CROWN POINT, unhurried off the rail, bid saving ground through the final turn, came three wide into the lane, dueled close to deep stretch then grudgingly yielded toward the wire. NETWORK angled four wide into the opening turn, settled in outside through the backstretch, started his drive widest on the final turn then had nothing left for the stretch. ANDROMEDA'S HERO, unhurried, bid saving ground on the final turn, eased out toward the eighth pole and finished evenly. TANI MARU rated the pace just off the rail, was pressured into the final turn then showed no stretch response. NAUGHTY NEW YORKER was crowded steady into the first turn, showed no speed toward mid track then tired in the stretch. GOLDEN MAN rated close three deep and between horses on the backstretch then weakened leaving the final turn. DOCTOR VOODOO briefly settled into stride toward the outside after stumbling out of the gate, moved to close contention five wide on the opening turn, remained a presence outside on the backstretch but showed no further response on the final turn.
