Footnotes

DELTA PRINCESS was never far back toward the inside, continued saving ground through the final turn, rallied on the rail approaching the eighth pole, dug in with determination and was edging away the final yards. SOMETHING VENTURED rated just off the early pace inside, lacked room nearing the final turn, dueled gamely from the top of the stretch, had a short but brief lead in deep stretch then yielded the closing yards. CONEY KITTY (IRE) rated just off the pace outside, started her drive entering the stretch then dueled for show. WITH PATIENCE rated off the pace about the three path, lacked room through the upper stretch, found room near the sixteenth pole and finished evenly. LOJO rated close in the three path, gave chase on the final turn, took aim through the upper stretch then weakened from the furlong pole. JACQUI'S PROMISE rated a short lead off the rail, dueled between horses in an outward drift through the upper stretch then weakened the final furlong.
