SEVERUS rated the pace, was challenged through the turn then dueled off the rail through the stretch gradually moving clear. ON A WHIRL contested the lead through the turn then dueled gamely down on the rail in the stretch and weakened in the final sixteenth. ANNE ENGLISH raced off the pace and evenly. DR. JESSIE chased the pace then had nothing left in the stretch. CARD SOUND raced off the pace saving ground then had no stretch response. SWEEPIN UP was steadied and dropped back early on angling to the far outside then was empty. JOCY'S COYOTE was outrun. GET IT IN GEAR was outrun. CLIFDEN STAR chased the early pace and tired six wide on the turn.
