SLEWS FINAL ANSWER showed no early speed toward the outside, started her drive entering the stretch, was driven up nearing the seventy yard pole then cleared in the closing strides. LAVENDER LASS showed no speed saving ground, made up ground through the turn, eased out into the stretch then finished well in place. UMPATEEDLE was kept just off the pace and off the rail, made her drive taking the lead toward the eighth pole, was briefly clear then outfinished. BRIGHT GOLD chased the pace inside, lacked room through the upper stretch, eased slightly out around the tiring pacesetter in midstretch, looked a factor a sixteenth out then leveled off. CUPID SEASON bobbled slightly after the start, dropped back early outside and never factored widest. ELECTRICAL CARLITA was quickly clear to set a fast pace inside, pressured into the stretch then weakened on the rail leaving the eighth pole. KUANYAN chased the early pace outside then weakened.
