**Footnotes**

IN ACCORD rated back off the early pace, bid off the rail through the final turn then sustained a long stretch drive to get up the final yards. MECKE'S PRINCESS rated close off the rail, moved to the lead midway through the backstretch, drew clear approaching the quarter pole then outfinished in the final yards. CATERESS was shuffled back steadying soon after the start, settled into stride off the rail, steadied again while advancing near the final turn, eased out for the drive and was closing well late. STOMPING rated off the pace in the three path, made a bid entering the stretch, closed to late stretch then flattened stride. ALLISON'S EYES rated off the pace and off the rail, took aim entering the stretch but faltered in the drive. WILD ABOUT DEBBIE was kept off the pace outside and offered no rally. COPPER SPECIAL was fractious unseating her rider at the gate, shuffled back early on then outrun. LADY KREW broke inward, rated close toward the outside then weakened off the rail through the stretch. THE CANDY QUEEN showed no speed and offered no rally. PAULA'S APPROVAL rated close to the early pace from the inside then faded quickly through the final turn. NORTH EAST STAR took the early lead off the rail, showed the way to the middle of the backstretch then gave way nearing the quarter pole.
