Footnotes

OCTOBER WINDS rated off the pace three deep, moved alongside the pacesetter nearing the quarter pole then dueled clear of that one leaving the sixteenth. OUR JOY positioned herself along the rail to rate the pace, was challenged toward the quarter pole, responded to move clear into the lane then gave way to the winner in a duel from the eighth pole. NURSE CULKIN, unhurried toward mid track, advanced position five wide on the final turn and finished well. TELL NO ONE showed no speed inside, angled out nearing the quarter pole and closed mildly six wide. PRETTY PARTISAN rated off the pace toward mid track, bid into the final turn but leveled off from the eighth pole. SEA MISTRESS, unhurried inside, bid off the rail into the final turn, lacked room through the turn then leveled off. OLD MOTHER GOOSE was outrun. FRANKIE'S STAR rated close in the three path, was pressured off the rail through the final turn then weakened into the stretch. RED BIER was kept close inside then faded.
