Footnotes

DIAMOND STRIPES settled off the pace toward the outside after being shuffled back early, advanced toward contention widest on the backstretch, dueled to the lead nearing the eighth pole, edged clear drifting slightly out and held on well. ON BOARD AGAIN rated close to the pace inside, angled four wide making his bid leaving the final turn, briefly lost momentum in deep stretch as the winner drifted across his path and finished evenly. HESANOLDSALT rated close to the pace two deep, took aim on the leader into the final turn, had a short lead approaching the quarter pole then dueled between horses before leveling off toward the wire. GOTTTCHA GOLD rated the pace inside, was pressured into the final turn, remained a close factor to midstretch then gradually faded. HARBORAGE, unhurried inside, bid into the final turn, eased out for the drive and passed tiring rivals. AWFULLY SMART was kept off the pace in mid track and faded through the lane. FAIRBANKS rated just off the pace about the three path, gave chase into the final turn then had nothing left in the lane. HIGH COTTON rated just off the early pace about the four path then had no response on the final turn. A claim of foul against the winning rider, lodged by the rider of the runner-up, was dismissed.
