ADDEMUP sprinted clear, widened his advantage on the far turn and held his rivals safe through the stretch under good handling. RENOWN reserved early, lodged a strong bid on the far turn, moved six wide into the stretch and rallied. COURTING CAT settled in mid-pack, entered the stretch three wide and stayed on. UNCOMMON PLEASURE raced forwardly along the inside, remained inside for the stretch run but lacked the needed kick. WIND MAN was forced out five wide into the clubhouse turn, made a bid on the far turn but flattened out. WESTERN BLUFF never menaced. CAPTAIN FRANK chased the pace under light restraint and faltered on the far turn. LIBERTARIAN proved no factor. RAMADAM flashed speed between rivals and dropped back early.
