Footnotes

DARAGO racing just off the pace inside, angled five wide leaving the quarter pole, ran down the pace setter under an all out drive and edged in front in the last yards. BECKY SLATER rated the pace in hand, moved clear in the turn and remained clear until the final yards when headed nearing the wire, was outfinished. MAGICLY DELICIOUS kept well back, started a drive off the rail in the turn, angled about five wide in mid stretch and made her bid but too late. DOX CAT CALL was kept back in the early going, saved ground in the turn, angled off the rail in mid stretch and finished with energy. MS BROWN EYED GIRL was rated off the pace, drifted out a bit in the turn and ran evenly in the lane. NINJETTA was used to keep up with the pace setter, stayed close near the rail but weakened inside the sixteenth pole. WIFEWITHANATTITUDE raced in the back mostly and never was a threat. DESERT DAWNING, just off the pace in the seven path, dropped back in the turn then tired widest.
