Footnotes

POETIC ROMANCE rated off the pace outside, was widest through the turn, closed drifting slightly in through the stretch, took over shortly after leaving the furlong pole then edged clear the final sixteenth. BON APPEAL kept just off the pace off the rail, started her drive entering the stretch, reached place a sixteenth out and held on well. DUCK DOWN UNDER chased the pace from mid track, was steadied from between rivals in the three path on the turn, eased out for the drive and finished evenly. DANZATAMES AWARD chased the pace from the inside, lacked room inside entering the stretch, made a mild bid off the rail and finished evenly. LOVELY CANDLES pressured the pace toward the outside, came through the turn in the five path then proved empty in the stretch. WILDCAT WIDOW set a pressured pace from the inside, remained clear through the upper stretch then gave way the final furlong. POLLY'S FOLLY pressured the early pace, dropped back mid track on the turn then gave way. HASAPIKO was shuffled back at the start then never factored.
