CATESSA set the pace on the inside, responded when roused and moved clear, driving. FLAME SONG saved ground within striking distance, came a bit off the rail in upper stretch and finished evenly to earn the place. SATIATE raced three wide throughout and was outfinished for second. FRUITS raced off the pace, three wide on the turn and then rallied mildly four wide. LUVINHERISEASI raced between foes and tired. PUMPKIN SOUP pressed the pace on the outside and faded. KELES did not factor. WAY FAST BEAUTY was outrun.
