KROMIUM KOP settled well behind the dueling leaders, moved four wide into the stretch while assuming command and held sway under steady handling. HARLEQUIN SKY reserved along the inside, moved out five wide for the stretch run and stayed on willingly. WHITE HOLIDAY settled in the rear of the field, lodged a strong inside bid on the far turn, angled six wide at the head of the stretch and kept on. TANGANYIKA pressed the pace while three wide, continued three wide into the stretch and proved no match for the principles. TRIPPIN UP leaned in at the start bothering WEEKEND PALACE, set a contested pace and yielded in the stretch. GENTLE JOURNEY was outrun while six wide, entered the stretch seven wide and offered no response. WEEKEND PALACE was forced in at the start, brushed HOLLYWOODLAND, lingered toward the back of the field and proved no factor. HOLLYWOODLAND brushed at the start, was outpaced while four wide and never reached contention. REATA'S SHAKA chased the pace while three wide, dropped back on the far turn and finished exhausted.
