Footnotes

MI NARROW rank in the early stages, improved his best position along the inside on the final turn, swung out three wide entering the stretch and responded to steady pressure to get up in the final stages. A LITTLE LUCK in close attendance to the leaders along the inside, took the lead entering the stretch, dug in courageously and overtaken near the wire. CROWD PLEASER well back in the early stages, rallied four wide entering the stretch and finished well. ROBERTO'S PRIDE checked entering the first turn, found his best strides on the final turn, was caught four wide entering the stretch and finished gamely from the outside. FAMILY CALLING lacked a serious stretch kick. BOGATYR ran evenly along the inside late. PLEASANT FEELING set the pace early and weakened on the final turn. ST. SUNSET stalked the pace from the outside and tired.
