MICHELLE'S REQUEST, middle of pack wide, rallied 5 wide 1/4 pole, led from midstretch and just lasted. CAKE WALKIN stalked pace between horses, finished well. DANCING PROOF slow early, rallied 4 wide 1/4 pole and finished fastest. PALMBEACH PRINCESS pressed pace into stretch, fought it out gamely and weakened late. CASSIDY'S CODE saved ground, passed tiring rivals. BLOOMIN BEAUTIFUL set pressured pace, held a clear lead entering stretch and tired in midstretch. CHARMING EAGLE stalked pace inside, steadied midturn, lacked late response. EVENING DAME, middle of pack, 4 wide turn, no rally. BOOSWILLOW showed nothing. SUPER SAY was outrun.
