BANNON'S PICK advanced to the lead early rating the pace just off the rail, extended her lead through the final turn then widened further through the stretch under steady handling. IS THAT YOU rated back in mid track, made a bid in the three path on the final turn then finished evenly. GOLD N FANCY angled to the inside and raced unhurriedly to the final turn, started her bid saving ground through the turn then finished evenly on the rail. TIME TO JAZZ was kept close on the outside, steadied while trying to get in nearing the final turn then faded. ON THE DECK chased the pace to the top of the stretch then weakened. LAST QUEEN had a brief early lead, rated close to the front then faded after the opening half mile.
