Footnotes

SPLASHING ROSE rated the pace on the inside, dueled off the rail dropping back a head in midstretch then came back gamely between horses to get the nod. WHATSERNAME rated close in the five path, sustained a long stretch drive dueling three wide and just missed the final jump. DEPARTING SOUTH (ARG) rated just off the pace on the inside, slipped through on the rail entering the stretch, dueled gamely to the wire but was outfinished in the final jump. MERC'S COMET rated close in the four path, remained a factor through the upper stretch then leveled out from the furlong pole. SHE DID IT HER WAY raced unhurriedly three and four wide then offered no rally. DRUM MONEY was kept off the pace and provided no rally. DEVIL IN PINK chased the pace toward the outside and gave way.
