INFLUENCE raced close up inside, came through on the rail passing the quarter pole, drew clear and held well under urging. TURINI raced three wide early, settled off the pace, was three wide on the far turn, came five wide into the stretch and rallied for second. GALACTICO settled off the rail, went six wide turning for home and rallied mildly outside. BERNI DE MINT pulled early, saved ground, came through on the rail and lacked a bid. KILDARE stalked two wide, raced between horses on the far turn and tired. ROARS MORE did not factor. HEROIC ROYAL set the pace on the inside and faded. SIR GUS pulled and was steadied twice in the early stages, chased outside, bid three wide on the far turn and tired.
