RUN KUSH RUN had an alert break, raced quickly clear and was never challenged while kept to a drive. ORO DE MEXICO was never far back, advanced inside entering the turn, angled five wide in mid turn, made his bid through the stretch and took the edge for place. ISTINTAJ chased the pace and had no stretch gain. SAN NICOLAS showed no early speed, saved ground through the turn, was taken to the outside in midstretch and offered a mild late bid. LITTLE LEE, off the pace, raced evenly. FETCH DINNER chased the pace and was used up for the drive. MAX'S PAL lunged out of the gate and was hustled up to contention, saved ground through the turn then showed no stretch response. LOADED GUN raced just off the pace through the backstretch then faded on the outside of the turn. NORMANDY BEACH ran six wide through the turn and tired.
