**Footnotes**

VOLPONI was rated close to the pace, made his bid around the top two at the quarter pole, dueled to the lead in midstretch and moved clear in the final sixteenth. BURNING ROMA was rated close, started his bid nearing the quarter pole, dueled with the winner to midstretch then weakened in the final sixteenth. GIANT GENTLEMAN rated the pace, was tested entering the far turn, held on dueling to late stretch then grudgingly let go on the rail. BOWMAN'S BAND raced just off the pace toward the outside, dropped back off the rail through the far turn then tired. WOODMOON vied for the lead through the backstretch, dropped back from between horses at the quarter pole then gave way in the stretch. DASH 'N DANCE raced unhurriedly and showed no response.
