STORM HEN broke inward, rated the early pace mid track, ran off the rail through the turn then responded well to stretch pressure to remain clear. AWANDA broke in, chased the pace from the outside, came through the turn in the three path then finished evenly while clear for place. MELISSA LEE chased the pace from the inside, eased out for room on the turn and finished evenly. BEST INTERVIEW chased the pace toward mid track then made a mild even outside bid. TERRA CYNTHUS dropped back early outside, showed no speed and no rally. MYTIC OUT was jostled at the start, rated close off the rail, dropped back inside entering the stretch then gave way. TALKIN SARATOGA was pinched back steady sharply at the start and never factored. A brief stewards inquiry provided no changes
