DE ROSE COLONY rated well just off the rail then responded gamely to stretch pressure, lasting under a steady drive. NATALIE'S MOMENT rated close to the lead toward the inside, angled three wide for the drive, gathered momentum from midstretch and was closing with every stride. WHATA SMOOTHIE raced unhurriedly, advanced saving ground through the final turn, was eased out in midstretch and closed well with a late rush. BORN GOLDEN rated off the pace on the inside, remained close on the rail through the stretch but needed more. TANALLOVER rated back early, started a bid five wide on the final turn, closed to late stretch then leveled out. RED JELLY raced unhurriedly, made her bid angling out through the final turn and finished widest. SONOITA SUNSET rated just off the pace, ran evenly in the three path on the final turn then faded. SILVER BANSHEE showed no speed, was steadied inside entering the final turn and proved empty for the drive. QUEST DANCER rated just off the pace, was four wide through the final turn and had no rally. ANNETTOS PRIZE showed no speed, tried in the four path on the final turn but was empty for the drive. COOL FASTNESS gave way after half. NANNIE'S SWORD stalked the lead in the three path, gave chase into the final turn then gave way.
