Footnotes

DULCITO was rated back off the pace, made a four wide bid through the far turn, dueled to the lead in midstretch then held on. SWEET SORROW, off the pace, lacked room through the far turn, angled out for the drive and closed well through the stretch. LA CAT stalked the pace down the backstretch, challenged the pacesetter through the far turn, had the lead entering the stretch then weakened in the final sixteenth. SUNSCREEN angled out for the drive, brushed HALLEY'S FIELD entering the stretch and closed well. IZONA raced just off the pace to the inside, was boxed in through the far turn, angled out in midstretch but showed no response from there. TWILIGHTS PRAYER rated the pace, was tested inside through the far turn then weakened nearing midstretch. CURRENTLY IN was outrun. HALLEY'S FIELD was brushed entering the stretch and was no factor. BLACK IT OUT raced close up to the early pace then weakened from the quarter pole. STAFINA stalked the pace early on, dropped back from between horses near the quarter pole then gave way.
